

JEREMY COMPLETES SECOND LONDON MARATHON RAISES OVER £35K FOR ROYAL SURREY CANCER CAMPAIGN

Jeremy successfully - and exhaustingly! - ran his second London Marathon in April, raising over **£35,000** for the new Royal Surrey Cancer & Surgical Innovation Centre. So far Jeremy's campaign has raised more than £360,000 on top of the £25 million he secured for the Centre

from outgoing NHS England Chief Executive Simon Stevens.

Jeremy ran the Marathon with friends of his brother Charlie who ran the Marathon with him last October. "What keeps you going are the remarkable crowds clapping and cheering - alongside singers, choirs

and bands who keep the atmosphere upbeat and stop you thinking too much about the pain in your feet," commented Jeremy.

The Royal Surrey's Cancer and Surgical Innovation facility will allow an extra 7,000 patients to be treated every year.

The Royal Surrey is a regional centre for cancer services supporting a population of up to 3 million

(around 4.5% of the UK's population)
